Poland as a case study...



- 38 mln citizens
- low rate of urbanisation (60%)
- 444 EUR – monthly median income
- 17% at risk of income poverty
- regional differences

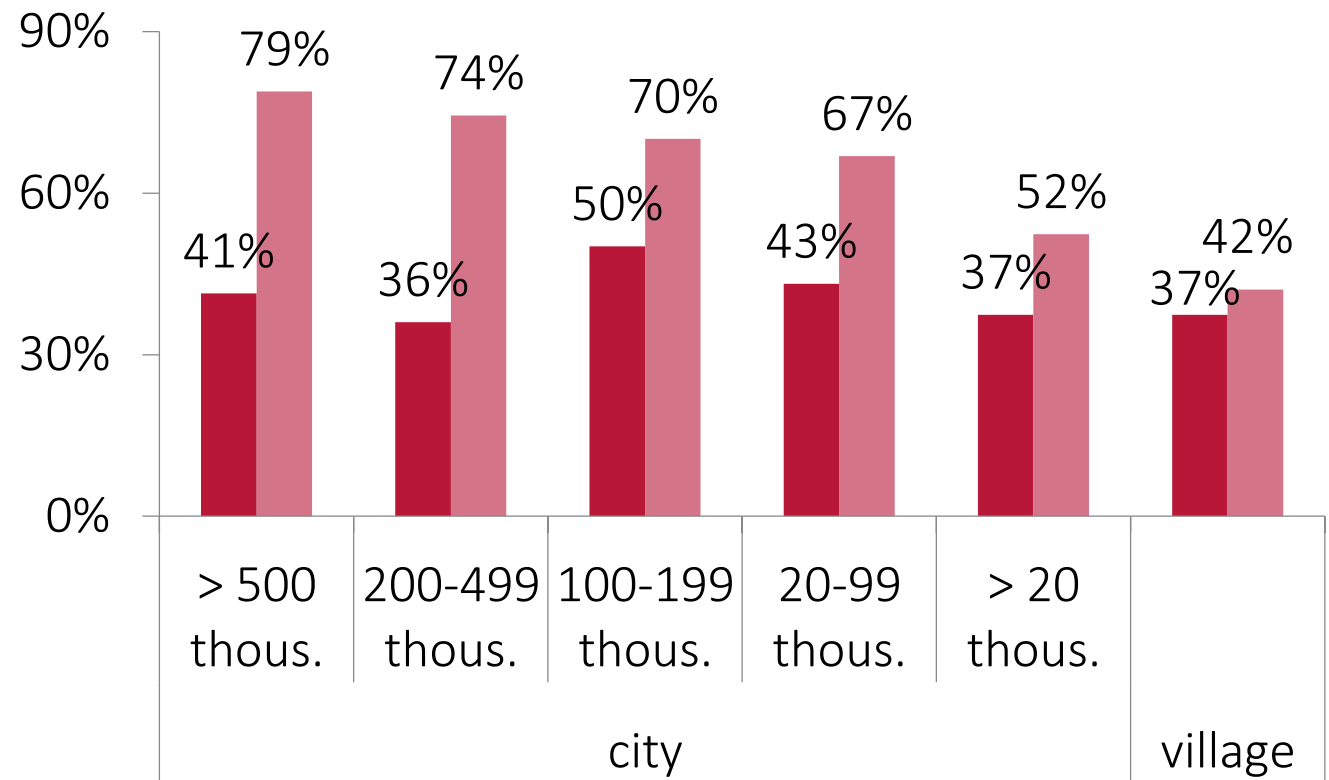


LHC fuel poverty in Poland in 2014: 9,6% of HH

■ buildings features ■ socio-economic features

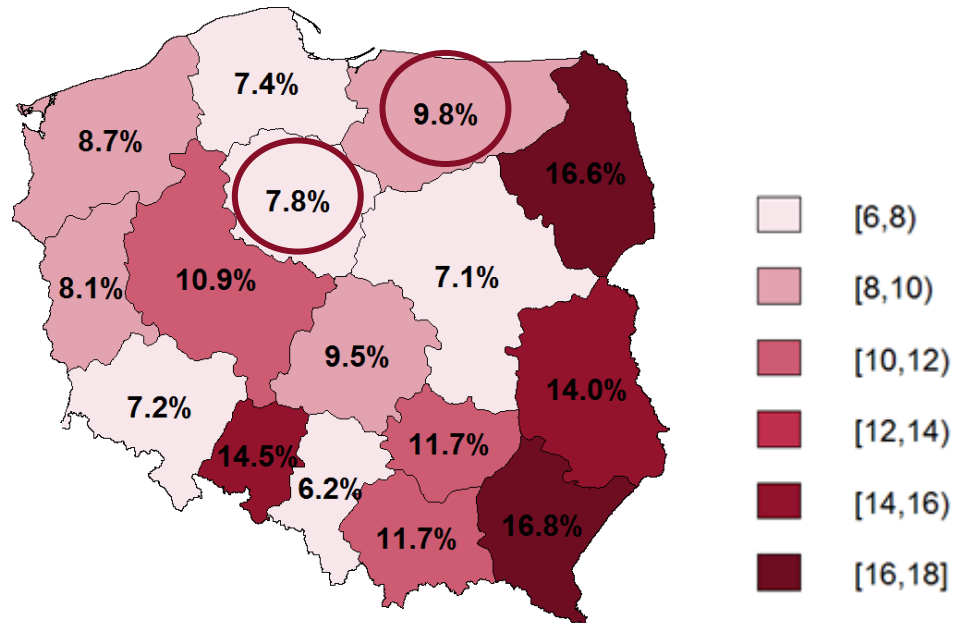


- Especially inhabitants of:

 - ...and retirees and pensioners **in villages**

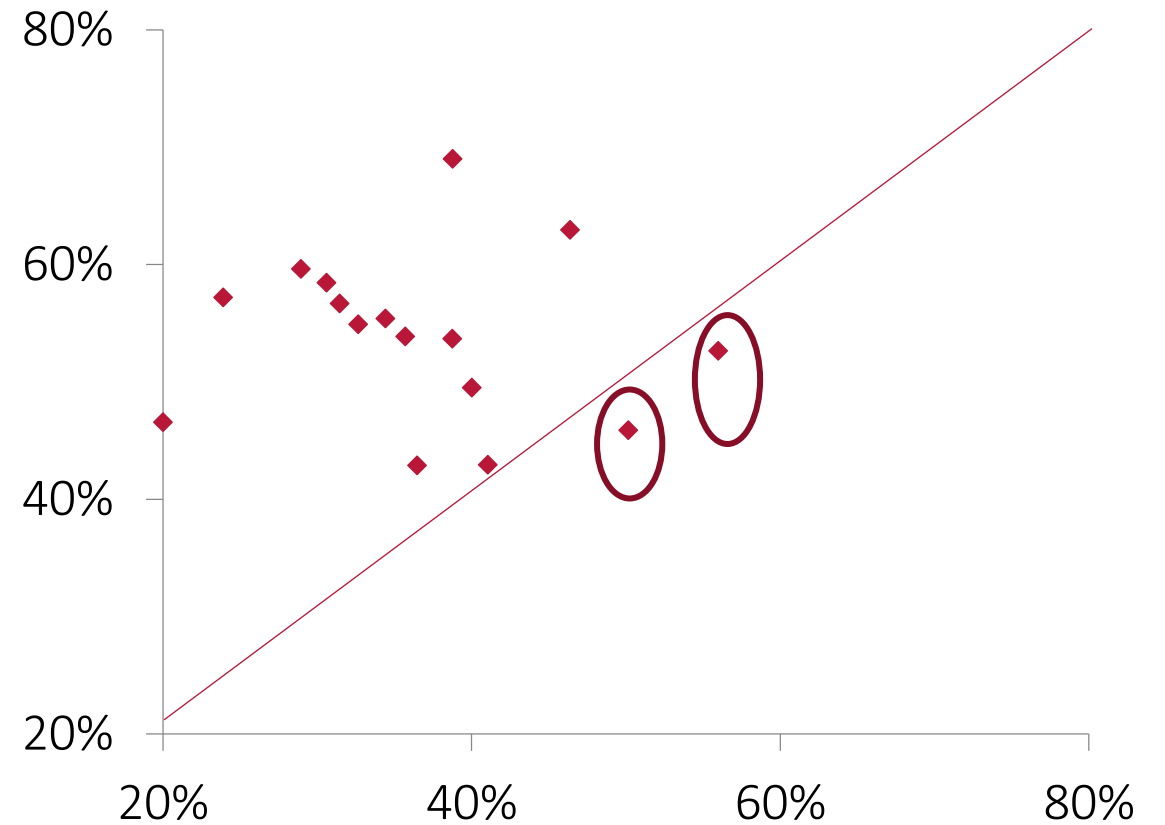
Regional variation of LIHC ← socio-economics factors

features contribution

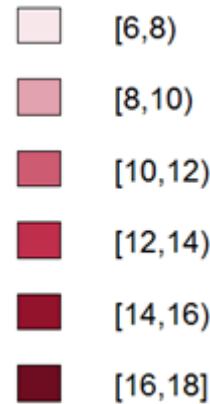
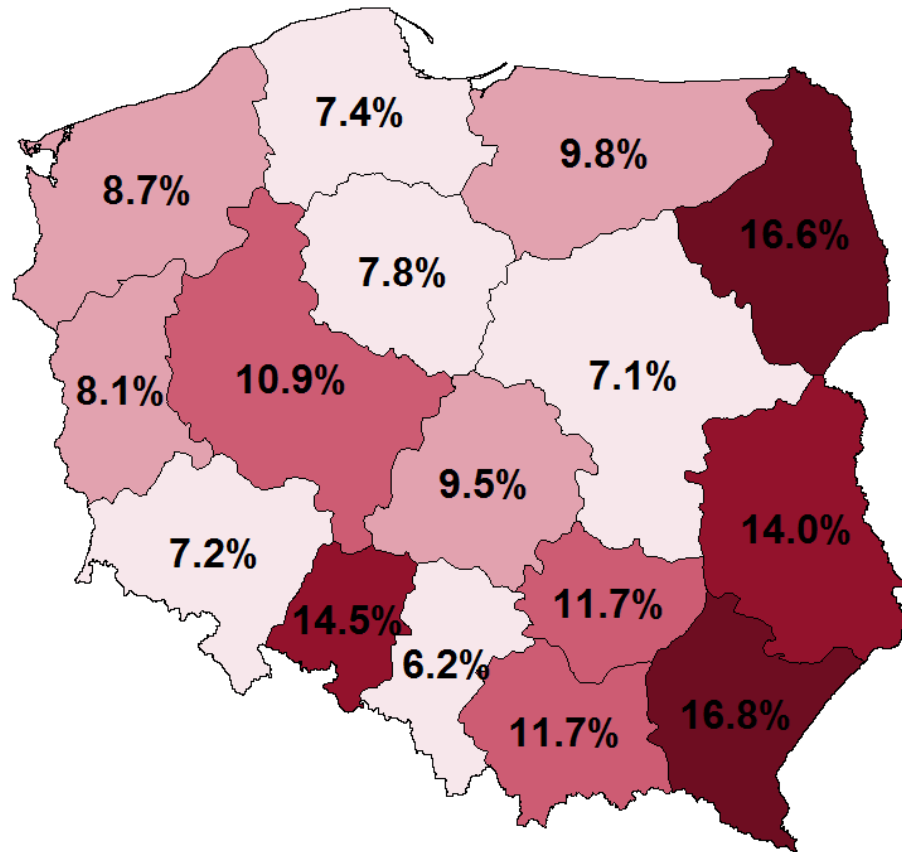


Buildings features contribution

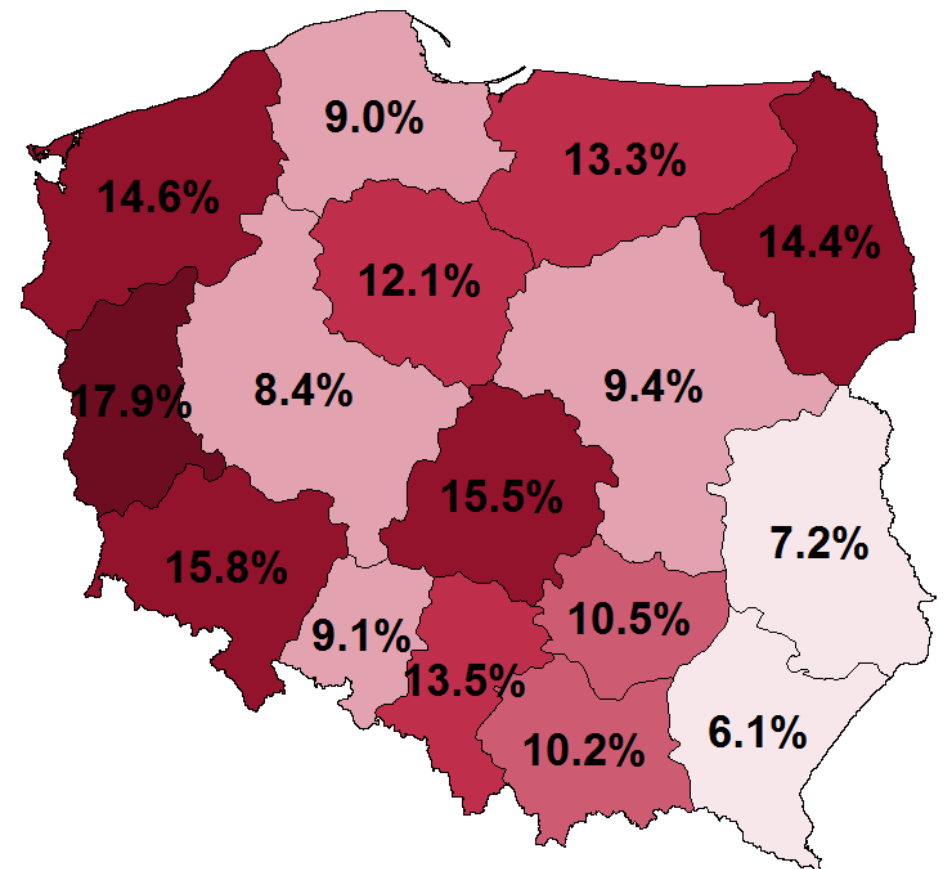
