Bridging the gap

The EU is focusing its **policy action** within a framework of energy efficiency, the decarbonisation of the economy and a clean and just energy transition.

Existing national strategies have specific advantages, but face challenges to catch the **multidimensionality** of the concept.

There is an emerging need for **tools** and **methodologies** to address energy poverty in a holistic way and to assess its direct benefits and co-benefits from energy efficiency actions.

Local authorities are crucial actors, but face limited knowledge and capacity to tackle energy poverty in private multi-family buildings.

The approach

LOCATEE's evidence-based and collaborative approach will be implemented in 3 pilot municipalities in Central, Southern and Southeastern Europe: [Rumia \(Poland\)](#), [Torres Vedras \(Portugal\)](#) and [Piraeus \(Greece\)](#).

We will also ensure **scaling up** the LOCATEE framework to more municipalities and regions across Europe.
